Storage options:

OPTION 1: Seamount Storage (behind Shell in Gibsons)

- **Description**: 8 x 20 Heated Storage Unit
- Cost: \$275 per month
- Benefits:
 - Ability to build racking to maximize space utilization.
 - Can accommodate all our equipment, including game jerseys, in a single location.
 - Potentially sell the current sea can for approximately \$3,500, offsetting the cost.
- Totality: This option provides climate-controlled storage and consolidated access to our items.

OPTION 2: Sunshine Storage (across from Gibsons IGA)

- **Description**: Non-heated 10 x 13 Storage Unit
- Cost: \$235 per month
- Benefits:
 - Slightly lower monthly cost.
 - However, space may be tight and could lead to accessibility issues.
- **Totality**: While affordable, the need for effective organization within a cramped space may impact our operational efficiency.

OPTION 3: First Response Storage

- **Description**: Current sea can storage in Marek's yard in Gibsons
- **Cost**: \$200 per month (includes power for a heater)
- Additional Costs:
 - \$750 for spray foam insulation for climate control.
- Benefits:
 - Lower monthly cost and includes heating.
 - Stacy will ensure the necessary cleaning and sealing of the floor.
- **Totality**: This option allows us to maintain usage of our sea can, albeit with a one-time upfront investment for insulation.

Seamount Storage has another unit coming available next month for us to consider tonight at the meeting:

Heated Unit 10'x23' plus mezzanine space (I have a video of this one to check out) = \$450 per month.
